Sub:- Application dated 29.04.2014 of the **Secretary, R.G.M. Shiksha & Sewa Samiti, Chandaus, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh** to establish a new Ayurveda college in the name of **Shaheed Narendra Kumar Ayurvedic Medical College & R.K.M.S. Charitable Hospital, Pisawa Road, Chandaus, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh** with 100 seats in BAMS course under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 –**Letter of Intent-regarding.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your application No. Nil dated 29.04.2014 on the subject cited above and to say that the proposal was sent to the Central Council of Indian Medicine on 25.07.2014 to examine the application, carry out an inspection of the proposed college and forward their recommendations. A copy of the letter was also sent to you.

2. After careful consideration of the scheme and taking into consideration the recommendations and visitation report of the CCIM in terms of the provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations/Norms made thereunder, the Ministry of AYUSH has decided to issue a **Letter of Intent** to the **Secretary, R.G.M. Shiksha & Sewa Samiti, Chandaus, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh** to establish a new Ayurveda college in the name of **Shaheed Narendra Kumar Ayurvedic Medical College & R.K.M.S. Charitable Hospital, Pisawa Road, Chandaus, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh** with 100 seats in BAMS course under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 from the academic session 2015-16 subject to the condition that following conditions shall be fulfilled before the inspection by the CCIM regarding the matter for consideration of permission for the academic session 2015-16, failing which Letter of Permission (LoP) shall not be issued and Letter of Intent (LoI) issued shall be deemed to be withdrawn:

- (i) the applicant shall fulfill the discrepancy of area of lecture halls as total area of 02 Lecture halls is reported only 280 sq.mt. against the requirement of 320 sq.mt. for college with 61-100 seats as per MSR. However, in detailed project report & map of floor plan in the application, the area is 320 sq.mt. for 2 halls & 400 sq.mt. each hall is mentioned respectively;

- (ii) the applicant shall fulfill all the relevant requirements of infrastructure for teaching and training facilities as specified in the Regulations 3 and 10 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda/Unani/Siddha Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012" read with amendment Regulations of 2013;
  - (iii) the applicant shall fulfil all the relevant requirements of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) (Amendment) Regulations, 2012" read with amendment Regulations of 2013;
  - (iv) the applicant shall fulfil all the relevant provisions of Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2003" read with amendment Regulations of 2013 and
  - (v) the applicant shall fulfil all the relevant provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970.
3. The college has also to submit the requisite performance bank guarantee of Rs.1.50 crore (Rupees one crore fifty lacs for upto 61-100 UG seats) as specified under the Regulation 6 (1) (g) of notified Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2003" read with amendment Regulations of 2013.
  4. The college administration has to ensure that no student is admitted in the above mentioned UG course till the formal Letter of Permission (LoP) by the Central Government is issued.
  5. In the event, the applicant college fails to comply with or satisfy the conditions of the Letter of Intent; the Letter of Intent shall be deemed to have been withdrawn, without further intimation to the applicant.
  6. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.
  7. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
