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Subject: Application dated 29.04.2014 of the **Secretary, R.G.M. Shiksha & Sewa Samiti, Chandaus, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh** to establish a new Ayurveda College in the name of **“Shaheed Narendra Kumar Ayurvedic Medical College & R.K.M.S. Charitable Hospital, Pisawa Road, Chandaus, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh”** with 100 seats in BAMS (UG) course under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 - **Permission letter for 60 UG seats (instead of 100 seats) - reg.**

Sir,

In continuation to the Ministry's letter of even No. dated 15.01.2015 wherein a Letter of Intent was issued to the applicant Samiti with respect to the proposal submitted to the Central Government as the subject cited above, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of the recommendations of the CCIM, observation of Hearing Committee based on the submission made by the Samiti during hearing and the representations of the Samiti dated 27.07.2015, 03.08.2015 & 14.08.2015 in terms of the criteria as specified in the Regulations 3 and 10 of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012, read with amendment Regulations of 2013”, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC), Ministry of AYUSH for the UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2015-16 vide Ministry's letter No.R.11011/01/2015-EP (IM-1) dated 05.05.2015(available on the Ministry's website: www.indianmedicine.nic.in); **permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to the Secretary, R.G.M. Shiksha & Sewa Samiti, Chandaus, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh** to establish a new Ayurveda Medical College in the name of **“Shaheed Narendra Kumar Ayurvedic Medical College & R.K.M.S. Charitable Hospital, Pisawa Road, Chandaus, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh”** with intake capacity of **60 seats** [instead of 100 seats as applied for, due to lack of requisite number of teachers i.e. minimum 09 (90% of 10) and minimum 05 higher faculties in 03 department as per MSR] in BAMS (UG) course from the academic session 2015-16 under the provisions of the section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970.

Therefore, the college may take admissions for 60 UG seats (instead of 100 seats) for the academic session 2015-16 subject to the condition that the following requirements should be fulfilled by the college positively by the 31st December, 2015 to get permission for the academic session 2016-17:

- (i) Relevant provisions of the Minimum Standards Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 and Regulation 10 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospital) Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013.
- (ii) Relevant requirements under the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) (Amendment) Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013 (for UG Ayurveda).

2. However, on examining the recommendation and inspection report of CCIM, it was found that the proposed college is having only 07 eligible teachers against the requirement of minimum 09 (90% of 10) teachers, only 03 higher faculties in 02 departments against the requirement of minimum 05 higher faculties in 03 departments (relaxed requirement) and not having at least 1HF+1L in each of 03 departments for 61 to 100 UG seats as per MSR. Therefore, under provision of first proviso to the sub section (5) of the section 13A of IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the applicant Samiti on 24.07.2015 vide letter of even no. dated 15.07.2015. The Samiti through its representatives appeared before designated Hearing Committee in the Ministry of AYUSH. In view of the observations the Hearing Committee based on the submission made by the college, it was found that the proposed college was having only 08 teachers, and 04 higher faculties in 03 departments at the time of CCIM visitation and the representatives of the applicant Samiti could not substantiate their claim of having minimum 09 (90% of 10) teachers, 05 higher faculties in 03 departments required for 61 to 100 UG seats as per MSR. However, with the available teaching faculties, the applicant Samiti is fulfilling the requirements for granting permission to establish a new Ayurveda college with 60 UG seats only (instead of 100 seats). Further, the representative of the Samiti has requested in his submission before Hearing Committee that if his submission is not considered for 100 seats, the same may be considered for 60 seats in BAMS. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to grant permission to the applicant Samiti to establish a new Ayurveda college with only 60 UG seats (instead of 100 seats as applied and LoI issued for) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the relevant CCIM Regulations, are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in the 1st professional of BAMS course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.

4. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for IInd, IIIrd and IVth professionals well in time as per the CCIM norms which will be verified and reported by the CCIM at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.

5. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
